In December 2023, SSE Renewables and FuturEnergy Ireland jointly submitted a planning application for the proposed 158MW, 22 turbine Glenora Wind Farm to An Bord Pleanála. We currently await a decision regarding that planning application.

The next stage of development for this project is to prepare and submit a planning application for the associated grid connection route and onsite substation. We may also make a separate planning application for an onsite battery energy storage system to Mayo County Council at some point in the future.

We are hosting a **public information evening on Tuesday 10th December from 2pm-7:30pm in Ballycastle Community Hall** for the local community to find out more about our plans ahead of a planning submission date in early 2025. This is an opportunity to view information, meet the Project Team, ask any questions you may have and provide feedback.

Prior registration is not required.
